APPENDIX 17

PREAMBLE

The English version of this Appendix is not binding to the parties. The Portuguese version of the document is the only official version of the auction and it is binding to all stakeholders. Should any interpretation doubt arise between this English version and the Portuguese version of this Appendix 17, the Portuguese version shall prevail, as the only official document for the auction.

Definitions for the Administrative Concession Contract for the services of public lighting at the City of Aracaju, including the development, modernization, expansion, efficiency energy, operation and maintaining of the Municipal Public Lighting Grid.

1. For the purposes of interpretation of the CONTRACT and its APPENDIXES, and notwithstanding other definitions established herein, the following definitions apply for the following expressions:

1.1. ABNT: Brazilian Association of Technical Standards (*Associação Brasileira de Normas Técnicas*), entity responsible for the technical standards applicable in Brazil, providing inputs to the Brazilian technological development;

1.2. ACCEPTANCE TERM: Document issued by the INDEPENDENT VERIFIER for receipt of PUBLIC LIGHTING POINTS, as provided in the CONTRACT and its APPENDIXES;

1.3. ACCESSORY REVENUE: Revenue obtained through the performance of RELATED ACTIVITY;

1.4. ACT OF GOD OR FORCE MAJEURE: Unpredictable, inevitable and irresistible event, which affects the contract performance, such as, but not limited to floods, earthquakes, and wars, in consonance with article 393, sole paragraph of the Brazilian Civil Code;

1.5. ADDITIONAL PUBLIC LIGHTING POINT: PUBLIC LIGHTING POINTS requested by the GRANTING AUTHORITY in the cases and conditions provided for in the CONTRACT;

1.6. APPENDIX: each of the documents attached to the CONTRACT;

1.7. ASSUMPTION DATE: Date on which the CONTRACT will become fully effective, with ASSUMPTION of SERVICES by the CONCESSIONAIRE, as provided in the CONTRACT;

1.8. BASE REGISTRY: Initial registration of the set of equipment's of the MUNICIPAL PUBLIC LIGHTING GRID presented by the CONCESSIONAIRE, following the guidelines provided in the APPENDIX 4 and 5;

1.9. BID NOTICE: PUBLIC BIDDING No. 01/2020;

1.10. BOUND ACCOUNT: Current account owned by the GRANTING AUTHORITY, opened with the DEPOSITARY FINANCIAL INSTITUTION, with exclusive transactions set forth by the DEPOSITARY FINANCIAL INSTITUTION, under the terms provided in the CONTRACT, designated to receive the revenue from the collection of COCIP sent on by DISTRIBUTION COMPANY, make payments and rebalance the MINIMUM FUND OF THE RESERVE ACCOUNT, according to the CONTRACT WITH THE DEPOSITARY FINANCIAL INSTITUTION;

1.11. CONCESSION AREA: Area corresponding to the entire territory of the MUNICIPALITY, encompassing all PUBLIC LIGHTING POINTS and all the infrastructure of the MUNICIPAL PUBLIC LIGHTING GRID contained within this territorial boundary;

1.12. CREDIT BANK: Set of credits made available to the GRANTING AUTHORITY for the request of demands of COMPLEMENTARIE SERVICES, according to the rules provided in APPENDIX 5 and other contractual provisions;

1.13. COCIP: Contribution to the Cost of the Public Lighting Services (*Contribuição para o custeio da Iluminação Pública*), created by Municipal Law No. 4.453/2013, that funds the services of PUBLIC LIGHTING;

1.14. COMMERCIAL PROPOSAL: Offer given by the CONCESSIONAIRE in the PUBLIC BIDDING that preceded the CONTRACT, embodied in the lowest amount of MAXIMUM MONTHLY PAYMENT offered;

1.15. COMPLEMENTARY SERVICES: Services provided by the CONCESSIONAIRE in response to requests made by the GRANTING AUTHORITY for: (i) installation of PUBLIC LIGHTING POINTS as provided in Clause 17; and/ or (ii) operation and maintenance of ADDITIONAL PUBLIC LIGHTING POINTS installed by ENTREPRENEURS;

1.16. CONCESSION: Administrative concession for the provision of SERVICES, under the provisions, terms and conditions established in the CONTRACT and its APPENDIX;

1.17. CONCESSIONAIRE (SPC): Specific Purpose Company - SPC, to be constituted by the winning bidder in accordance with the laws of the Federative Republic of Brazil, with the sole purpose of operating the CONCESSION;

1.18. CONCESSION MILESTONES: Set of deliveries foreseen for MODERNIZATION AND EFFICIENTIZATION of the MUNICIPAL PUBLIC LIGHTING GRID, as well as for the implementation of the REMOTE SYSTEM and for the works for SPECIAL LIGHTING provided in APPENDIX 5;

1.19. CONCESSION TERM: Duration of the CONCESSION, counted from the ASSUMPTION DATE, which may be changed or extended as provided in the CONTRACT;

1.20. CONTRACT: ADMINISTRATIVE CONCESSION AGREEMENT No. [•]/2020;

1.21. CONTRACT VALUE: Sum of all MAXIMUM MONTHLY PAYMENTS due by GRANTING AUTHORITY to the CONCESSIONAIRE through the CONCESSION TERM;

1.22. CONTRACT WITH THE DEPOSITARY FINANCIAL INSTITUTION: Agreement entered into between the GRANTING AUTHORITY, the CONCESSIONAIRE and the DEPOSITARY FINANCIAL INSTITUTION, for the

opening of the BOUND ACCOUNT for the transit of COCIP funds in order to make payments due to the CONCESSIONAIRE under the CONTRACT;

1.23. CORRECTIVE MAINTENANCE: Service performed by the CONCESSIONAIRE as a corrective action upon receipt of maintenance calls, as a result of failures, theft, vandalism or poor performance;

1.24. DEPOSITARY FINANCIAL INSTITUTION: FINANCIAL INSTITUTION in which the BOUND ACCOUNT and the RESERVE ACCOUNT will be opened, contracted jointly by the GRANTING AUTHORITY and by the CONCESSIONAIRE for the provision of the custody, management and administration services of the amounts used in the CONCESSION for the payment of the MONTHLY EFFECTIVE PAYMENT in favor of the CONCESSIONAIRE, and other obligations under the CONTRACT;

1.25. D.O: Official Gazette of City of Aracaju;

1.26. DISTRIBUTION COMPANY: Federal concession holder to provide the distribution of public electricity in the CONCESSION AREA;

1.27. EFFECTIVE MONTHLY PAYMENT: Actual amount that will be paid monthly by the GRANTING AUTHORITY to the CONCESSIONAIRE due to the performance of the CONTRACT, through the DEPOSITARY FINANCIAL INSTITUTION, calculated from the MAXIMUM MONTHLY PAYMENT and after the GENERAL PERFORMANCE INDEX, as provided in APRENDIX 8, according to the CONCESSION MILESTONES, as described in APPENDIX 9;

1.28. EMERGENCY MAINTENANCE: Service performed by the CONCESSIONAIRE as a corrective action in cases where there is a risk to the physical integrity of the USERS or the MUNICIPALITY's assets;

1.29. EMURB: Municipal Company of Urban Service;

1.30. ENERGY BONUSES: BONUSES that the CONCESSIONAIRE will be entitled in the hypothesis of additional saving in the energy consumption related to the PUBLIC LIGHTING, after the achievement of the efficiency target, based on the calculation rules;

1.31. ENERGY EFFICIENCY TARGET: Efficiency target for the MUNICIPAL GRID OF INITIAL PUBLIC LIGHTING set out in APPENDIX 5 and which directly impacts the BONUS value on the ENERGY BONUSES;

1.32. ENERGY SUPPLY AGREEMENT: Energy supply agreement for the PUBLIC LIGHTING of the MUNICIPALITY entered into between the MUNICIPALITY and the DISTRIBUTION COMPANY;

1.33. ENTREPRENEURS: Entrepreneurs, constructors, builders and other third parties authorized by the GRANTING AUTHORITY, or other body or entity of the municipal PUBLIC ADMINISTRATION, to install POINTS OF PUBLIC LIGHTING;

1.34. FINANCERS: FINANCIAL INSTITUTIONS or other entitles that grant funding to the CONCESSIONAIRE or represent the creditor parties in this financing;

1.35. FINANCIAL CONTRACT: Each of the contracts, public deeds for the issuance of securities, credit securities or other equivalent instruments whereby financing, or resources are granted to the CONCESSIONAIRE, in any of the modalities permitted by law, to support its obligations under this CONTRACT;

1.36. FINANCIAL INSTITUTIONS: Commercial banks, development banks, multilateral agencies, credit agencies, fiduciary agents, payments of funds or other entities that grant financing to the CONCESSIONAIRE, or represent as creditor parties in that financing concession;

1.37. GRANTING AUTHORITY: City of Aracaju, through the Secretariat of Public Services;

1.38. GENERAL PERFORMANCE INDEX: Index calculated quartely, as explained in APPENDIX 8, and which reflects the performance of the SERVICES rendered by the CONCESSIONAIRE. The PERFORMANCE INDEX will determine the value of the PERFORMANCE PARAMETER that will impact EFFECTIVE MONTHLY PAYMENT, as specified in APPENDIX 9;

1.39. GOVERNANCE COMMITTEE: Committee created by the PARTIES in order to coordinate, integrate and discipline the efforts of the PARTIES during the performance of the services granted and also the services that compete to the

GRANTING AUTHORITY, including the responsibility of acting with the DISTRIBUTION COMPANY or others competent organs;

1.40. GROUP OF PUBLIC LIGHTING POINTS: Classification of PUBLIC LIGHTING POINTS, in accordance with the localization, according to whether they appear in ROUTES WITH REMOTE SYSTEM;

1.41. IPCA: Broad National Consumer Price Index (*Índice Nacional de Preços ao Consumidor Amplo - IPCA*), released by the Brazilian Institute of Geography and Statistics (*Instituto Brasileiro de Geografia e Estatística – IBGE*);

1.42. INITIAL SERVICE ORDER: Communication sent by the GRANTING AUTHORITY to the CONCESSIONAIRE so that it can take all the necessary measures for its mobilization for the beginning of Phase 0;

1.43. ISOLATED PUBLIC LIGHTING POINT: PUBLIC LIGHTING POINT in relation to which there is no other adjacent PUBLIC LIGHTING POINT on the same route at a distance of less than 90 (ninety) meters in either direction of the route;

1.44. INITIAL PUBLIC LIGHTING MUNICIPAL NETWORK: MUNICIPAL GRID OF PÚBLIC LIGHTING existing on the date of the CONTRACT signing;

1.45. INDEPENDENT VERIFIER: Company of specialized technical consulting, to be hired by the CONCESSIONAIRE, as provide into the CONTRACT and in APPENDIX 14;

1.46. LED: Light Emitting Diode, which consists of a technology of light conduction, from electricity;

1.47. LINKED ASSETS: All the assets used by the CONCESSIONAIRE in the CONTRACT performance, encompassing the assets which the CONCESSIONAIRE owns domain, the ones which the GRANTING AUTHORITY give away the use to the CONCESSIONAIRE and also the ones that the CONCESSIONAIRE has the guard duty;

1.48. LINKED REVENUE: Revenue obtained through the collection of COCIP used to fund the services of PUBLIC LIGHTING, ensuring the full, punctual and faithful performance of the obligations contracted by the GRANTING AUTHORITY;

1.49. LIQUIDITY BALANCE: Liquidity balance to be composed by the GRANTING AUTHORITY to support the payment of MONTHLY EFFECTIVE PAYMENT, through the transfer of COCIP revenues, under the terms of the CONTRACT and its APPENDIX;

1.50. LIGHTING CLASS: Category of LIGHTING of a specific route in accordance with the guidelines set out in APPENDIX 13, which may be V1, V2, V3, V4 or V5 in the case of vehicle routes and P1, P2, P3 or P4 in case of pedestrian routes;

1.51. LOWER RANGE (LP): Percentage of minimum adherence of REGISTRY in relation to the BASE REGISTRY that does not entail economic-financial rebalancing;

1.52. LUMINAIRE: Equipment consisting of a light emitting module and other components, responsible for directing, fixing and protecting the light source and its auxiliary lighting, operation and control devices;

1.53. MARGINAL CASH FLOW: Projection of the variation in the performance of the CONCESSIONAIRES' cash account, measuring the influence of changes in operations, investments and financing activities resulting from an event on the CONCESSIONAIRE' cash, in the cases and conditions expressly establish in the CONTRACT;

1.54. MAXIMUM MONTHLY PAYMENT: Amount described in the COMMERCIAL PROPOSAL;

1.55. MAXIMUM MONTHLY PAYMENT – INSTALLMENT A: Portion of the MAXIMUM MONTHLY PAYMENT due to the CONCESSIONAIRE in compliance with the CONCESSION MILESTONES;

1.56. MAXIMUM MONTHLY PAYMENT – INSTALLMENT B: Portion of the MAXIMUM MONTHLY PAYMENT due to the CONCESSIONAIRE from the beginning of Phase I, as provided for in the CONTRACT;

1.57. MINIMUM BALANCE OF THE RESERVE ACCOUNT: Number of MAXIMUM MONTHLY PAYMENTS that must be kept in the RESERVE ACCOUNT throughout the CONCESSION, in accordance with APPENDIX 12;

1.58. MODERNIZATION AND STREAMLINING ENERGY: Engineering works and services that involve the updating of lighting technology and improvements in the infrastructure of the MUNICIPAL GRID OF INITIAL PUBLIC LIGHTING, according to the provisions expressed in APPENDIX 5;

1.59. MODERNIZATION PLAN: Plan prepared by the CONCESSIONAIRE containing the detailed description of the SERVICES, in accordance with the guidelines set out in APPENDIX 5;

1.60. MODERNIZED PUBLIC LIGHTING POINT: PUBLIC LIGHTING POINT whose lighting parameters and efficiency targets meet the requirements set out in the CONTRACTS and its APPENDIX;

1.61. MODERNIZED AND STREAMLINED ENERGY MUNICIPAL PUBLIC LIGHTING NETWORK: Part of the PUBLIC LIGHTING MUNICIPAL GRID whose lighting parameters, energy efficiency goals and REMOTE SYTEM are fully in accordance with the requirements set out in the APPENDIX 5;

1.62. MUNICIPALITY: City of Aracaju/SE;

1.63. MUNICIPAL TRAFFIC AUTHORITY: Municipal body responsible for traffic management in the MUNICIPALITY;

1.64. MUNICIPAL PUBLIC LIGHTING NETWORK: Set of equipment that make up the PUBLIC LIGHTING infrastructure of the MUNICIPALITY, including all the PUBLIC LIGHTING POINTS;

1.65. OPERATIONAL CONTROL CENTER: Location designated to monitor and control the MUNICIPAL PUBLIC LIGHTING GRID, composed with structure, equipment and software of information technology that will allow the management of the MUNICIPAL PUBLIC LIGHTING GRID, from the patrimonial control, detection of failures, remote measurement of the energy consumption in the PUBLIC LIGHTING POINTS and the prioritization of the customer service and interventions in real time, despite the registries, dispatches and occurrences follow-up;

1.66. OPERATIONAL DEMOBILIZATION PLAN: Plan prepared by the CONCESSIONAIRE, containing the list of REVERSIBLE ASSETS and a detailed

description of the strategy for reversing the assets to the GRANTING AUTHORITY, according to the guidelines provided for in APPENDIX 5;

1.67. OPERATION AND MAINTENANCE PLAN: Plan to be prepared by the CONCESSIONAIRE containing the operation and maintenance strategy of the MUNICIPAL GRID OF INITIAL PUBLIC LIGHTING;

1.68. PARTIES: GRANTING AUTHORITY and CONCESSIONAIRE;

1.69. PAYMENT MECHANISM: Methodology used for the elaboration of the calculus of payment due to the CONCESSIONAIRE for the provision of SERVICES;

1.70. PERFORMANCE BOND: Guarantee that the CONCESSIONAIRE shall maintain, in favor of the GRANTING AUTHORITY, for the fulfillment of the contractual obligations;

1.71. PERFORMANCE MEASUREMENT SYSTEM: Set of criteria and technical specifications contained in APPENDIX 8, referring to the quality goals of the provision of SERVICES, which will be used to calculate the GENERAL PERFORMANCE INDEX, and, consequently, to determine the payment due to the CONCESSIONAIRE;

1.72. PERFORMANCE PARAMETER: Parameter of payment adjustment according to the performance presented by the CONCESSIONAIRE, guided by the GENERAL PERFORMANCE INDEX determined in the quarter prior to the payment, according to rules and guidelines presented in the APPENDIX 8 and 9;

1.73. PREDICTIVE MAINTENANCE: Service performed by the CONCESSIONAIRE aiming at the systematic and/or periodic monitoring of the parameters and/or performance conditions of the PUBLIC LIGHTING equipment, through statistical analyzes, aiming at the definition of interventions before the occurrence of failures and/or finding of poor equipment performance;

1.74. PREVENTIVE MAINTENANCE: Service performed by the CONCESSIONAIRE as a scheduled, periodic or systematic action, with the purpose of increasing the likelihood that the PUBLIC LIGHTING POINTS will operate within the expected useful life and avoid system failures;

1.75. PERFORMANCE STANDARDS: Standards to be followed by those interested in acting as an INDEPENDENT VERIFIER, to prove their experience in the provision of consultancy in the Social and Environmental area, as indicated in APPENDIX 14, in order to identify the risks related to the activities object of the CONCESSION and if the resulting impacts are evaluated, in order to promote adequate Social and Environmental Sustainability;

1.76. POLICY ON TRANSACTIONS WITH RELATED PARTIES: Document prepared and approved by the CONCESSIONAIRE's management bodies that must contain the rules and conditions for carrying out transactions between the CONCESSIONAIRE and its RELATED PARTIES;

1.77. PROJECTS FOR THE INSTALING ENTREPRENEURS OF VENTURES: Project for the installation of PUBLIC LIGHTING POINTS of an ENTREPRENEUR;

1.78. PUBLIC LIGHTING POINT: Set consisting of LUMINAIRE and accessories indispensable for its operation and support (lamp, LUMINAIRE, arms and supports for the installation of PUBLIC LIGHTING equipment, connectors, reactors, photoelectric relays and sockets for photoelectric relays), as well as, when applicable, by the power pole exclusive circuit for PUBLIC LIGHTING and its indispensable accessories (power pole, control boxes, switches, conduits, contactors and other materials not mentioned that integrate the PUBLIC LIGHTING facilities), regardless of the number of lamps and LUMINAIRES installed therein;

1.79. PUBLIC BIDDING: Public Bidding No. 01/2020;

1.80. PUBLIC LIGHTING: Service that has the exclusive objective of providing clarity to public places and goods of common use, periodically, continuously, or occasionally, includes SPECIAL LIGHTNING, except those aim at any form of advertising or publicity, for carrying out activities aimed at interests economical and services of traffic lights, radars and traffic monitoring cameras;

1.81. REBALANCING PARAMETER (RP): Index assigned by the GROUP OF PUBLIC LIGHTING POINTS, which determines the remuneration added or deducted from the MAXIMUM MONTHLY PAYMENT of the COMMERCIAL PROPOSAL, related to a number of points below the LOWER RANGE or above the UPPER RANGE;

1.82. REFERENCE QUANTITATIVE OF PUBLIC LIGHTING POINTS: Quantity of public LIGHTING points described in APPENDIX 5;

1.83. REVERSIBLE ASSETS: Necessary assets to the continuity of services related to the CONCESSION, which will be reverted to the GRANTING AUTHORITY at the end of the CONTRACT, including, but not limited to PUBLIC LIGHTING POINTS, installations, LIGHT FIXTURES, reactors, accessories, control equipment and remote monitoring of the MUNICIPAL PUBLIC LIGHTING GRID, according to APPENDIX 15;

1.84. REGISTRY: Registry, updated along the CONCESSION TERM, reflecting the composition of the MUNICIPAL PUBLIC LIGHTING GRID, according to the provisions of the CONTRACT and its APPENDIX;

1.85. RELATED ACTIVITY: Any activity, project or achievement associated to the CONCESSION, explored by the CONCESSIONAIRE;

1.86. RELATED PARTIES: In respect to the CONCESSIONAIRE, any controlling person affiliate and respective subsidiaries, as well as those considered by the accounting standards in force;

1.87. RESERVE ACCOUNT: Bank account owned by the GRANTING AUTHORITY, opened by the DEPOSITORY FINANCIAL INSTITUTION, with exclusive movement by the DEPOSITORY FINANCIAL INSTITUTION, which composition and recomposing of the minimum balance shall be equivalent to the dispositions of the APPENDIX 12;

1.88. ROADS WITH TELEMAGEMENT: Routes with PUBLIC LIGHTING POINTS with the implementation of the REMOTE SYSTEM, for the LIGHTING CLASS definite in the APPENDIX 5.

1.89. QUARTELY INDICATORS REPORT: Report prepared by the INDEPENDENT VERIFIER, which must be sent to the GRANTING AUTHORITY, to the CONCESSIONAIRE and to the DEPOSITORY FINANCIAL INSTITUTION, containing the calculation of the CONCESSIONAIRE'S GENERAL PERFORMANCE INDEX, according to the performance parameters contained in the APPENDIX 8, indicating also the EFFECTIVE MONTHLY PAYMENT for the following quarter;

1.90. SERVICES: PUBLIC LIGHTING SERVICES in the MUNICIPALITY, including the development, modernization, expansion, energy efficiency, operation, and maintenance of MUNICIPAL PUBLIC LIGHTING GRID as set forth in APPENDIX 5;

1.91. SERVICES DELIVERY TERM: Document signed by the PARTIES to the end of Phase 0, aiming the assumption, by the CONCESSIONAIRE, of the SERVICES, in compliance with terms and conditions established in the CONTRACT;

1.92. SERVICE ORDER: Communication sent by the GRANTING AUTHORITY to the CONCESSIONAIRE so that it can take all the necessary measures to carry out the executive project of the COMPLEMENTARY SERVICES;

1.93. SPECIAL AREAS: Routes where there are public unities (Hospitals, Health Unities, Schools, Cultural and Entertainment Centers, Courts, Police Departments etc.) with night operation, routes with a higher criminality index and routes near Urban Buses Terminals;

1.94. SPECIAL LIGHTING: PUBLIC LIGHTING services aimed at enhancing urban equipment such as bridges, viaducts, monuments, squares, facades and works of art of historical, cultural or landscape value, located in public areas within the CONCESSION AREA;

1.95. SUBCONTRACTED OPERATOR: Individual or legal entity hired by the CONCESSIONAIRE to perform technical supervision of the provision of the SERVICES or the provision of the SERVICES itself. In any case, the CONCESSIONAIRE will assume joint and several liability, remaining fully responsible for the services provided by the SUBCONTRACTED OPERATOR. For CONTRACT purposes, the obligations related to the CONCESSIONAIRE also reach the SUBCONTRACTED OPERATOR;

1.96. TECHNICAL COMMITTEE: All the committees composed, as established in the CONTRACT, to select the technical divergences and questions related to the financial-economic aspects during the CONTRACT performance;

1.97. TELEMANAGEMENT SYSTEM: System to be implemented by the CONCESSIONAIRE for information traffic, control and remote management of the PUBLIC LIGHTING POINTS indicated in APPENDIX 5;

1.98. TERMINAL PUBLIC LIGHTING POINT: PUBLIC LIGHTING POINT in which there is another PUBLIC LIGHTING POINT(S) adjacent to the same route at a distance of less than 90 (ninety) meters in only one of the directions of the route;

1.99. TERMS OF TRANSFER OF GOODS: Document signed by the PARTIES through which it is officialized the transfer of REVERSIBLE ASSETS, by the GRANTING AUTHORITY, to the CONCESSIONAIRE;

1.100. TERMS OF RECEIPT OF THE MODERNIZED AND EFFICIENTIZED MUNICIPAL PUBLIC LIGHTING GRID: Term issued by the GRANTING AUTHORITY after the issuance of all ACCEPTANCE TERMS concerning the CONCESSION MILESTONES provided for in the MODERNIZATION PLAN and in APPENDIX 5, which certifies the receipt of the MODERNIZED AND EFFICIENTIZED MUNICIPAL PUBLIC LIGHTING GRID;

1.101. TRAINING: Courses or workshops given by the CONCESSIONAIRE for the enhancement of knowledge from the GRANTING AUTHORITY staff about themes related to the CONCESSION;

1.102. UPPER RANGE (UP): Percentage of maximum adherence of REGISTRY in relation to the BASE REGISTRY that does not entail economic-financial rebalancing;

1.103. USERS: Set of those who benefit from the MUNICIPAL PUBLIC LIGHTING GRID;
